ECE 21 Child and Adolescent Development Units: 3

This course examines the progression of development in the physical, cognitive, social, and emotional domains and identifies developmental milestones for children from conception through adolescence. Emphasis on interactions between biological processes and environmental factors will occur. Students will observe children, evaluate individual differences, and analyze characteristics of development at various stages according to developmental theories. (UC, CSU, C-ID CDEV 100)

ENG 1A Reading & Composition

Units: 3

Advisories: Ability to read at the 12th grade level. Must submit prerequisite clearance form to enroll.

This course is a transfer-level, college freshman English composition course comparable to those courses offered by the state college and university systems. (UC, CSU, C-ID ENGL 100)

SOCIO 1A Intro to Sociology

Units: 3

Advisories: ENG 1A with a grade of "C" or better and ability to read at the 12th grade level.

An introductory study of the basic concepts, theoretical approaches, and methods of sociology. Topics typically include the analysis and explanation of social structure, group dynamics, socialization and the self, social stratification, culture and diversity, social change, and global dynamics. Course objectives include the ability to apply sociological ideas to everyday life.



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
