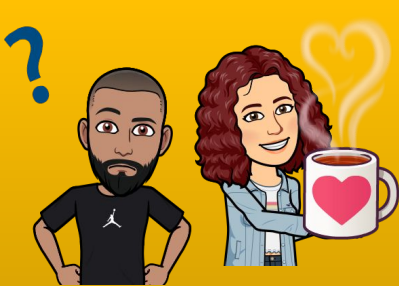

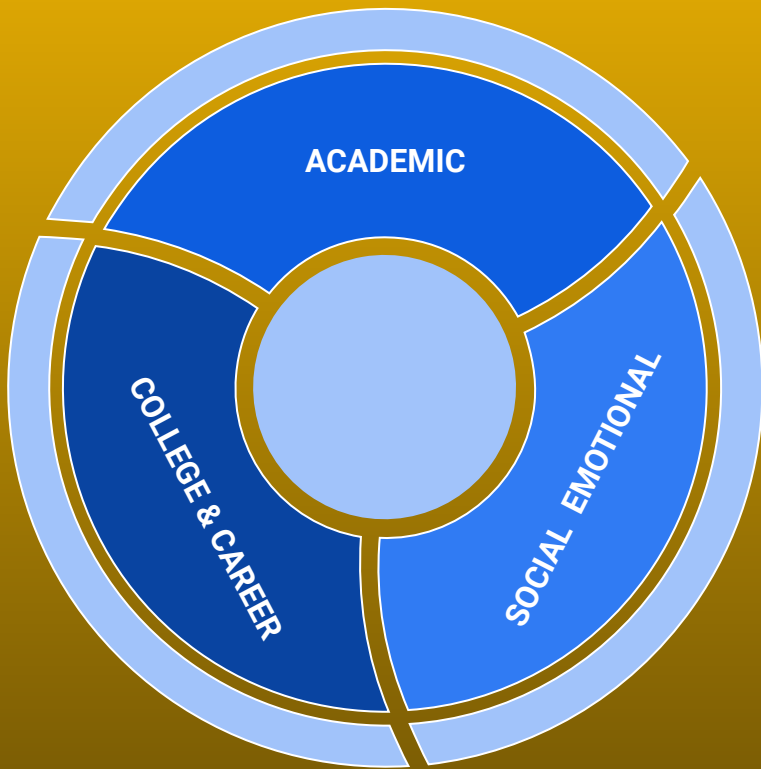

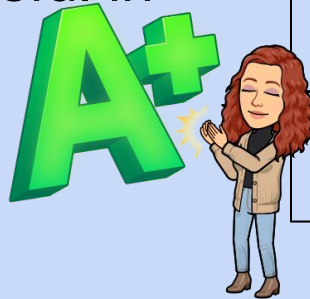

- Firefighter, fire engine engineer, arson investigator, etc.

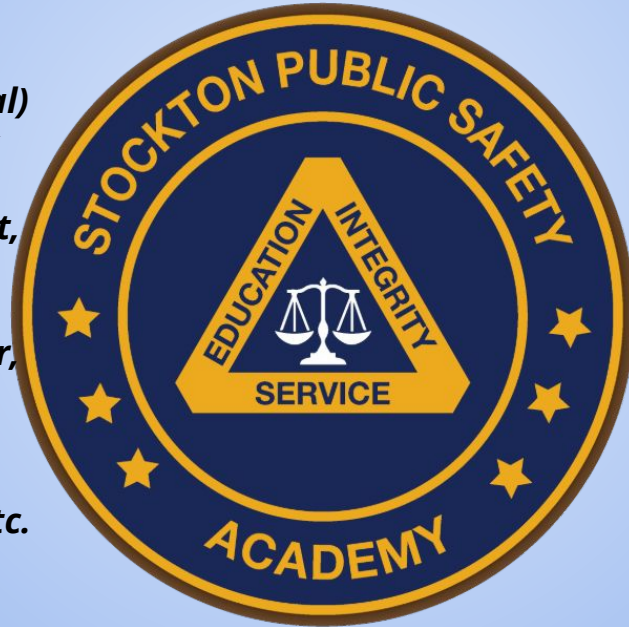


