### UNDERSTANDING GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)

For each grade you receive on your transcript, you will get points. These points will be averaged out to get calculate your GPA.


- A 4 points


#### AP ~ Advanced Placement



LET'S PRACTICE

- 1. Stretch your hand out like a star.
- 2. Get your pointer finger ready to trace your fingers up and down.
- 3. Slide up each finger slowly ~ slide down the other side.
- 4. Breathe in through your nose ~ out through your mouth.
- Put it together and breathe in as you slide up and breathe out as you slide down. Keep going until you have finished tracing your hand.
