

of the SUSD budget goes toward salaries and benefits for employees.

SUSD's commitment to investing in staff is supported in a side-by-side comparison with 9 other districts intentionally selected based on their location and/or their comparability as a district to SUSD. A closer look at first year salaries when adjusted to account for Health and Welfare benefits, finds that SUSD is among the most generous districts in regard to first year teacher take home pay.
