- Identifying and recruiting community leaders to serve on the fundraising committee.
- Analyzing relationships with current and prospective major donors and developing individualized strategies to cultivate and strengthen those relationships.
- Analyzing relationships with current and prospective sponsors, developing sponsorship packages, and working to develop those relationships.
- Working with fundraising staff of other organizations, such as Community Foundation of San Joaquin, in their efforts to raise money.
- Being responsible for involvement of all Board members in fundraising, such as having Board members make telephone calls to ask for support.
- Monitoring fundraising efforts to be sure that ethical practices are in place, that donors are acknowledged appropriately, and that fundraising efforts are cost-effective.
- Reporting back to the full Board during board meetings.
