# <u>ANALYSIS</u>

Amendment #1 to the Lease Lease Back Contract with C.T. Brayton and Sons, Inc. for the New Elementary School as Quail Lakes is a crucial component to maintaining the project schedule. This first bid package allows the District to proceed with all scope associated with the building abatement and demolition, soil removal and grading of the existing site in preparation for construction associated with the DSA approved scope of the project. No work associated with the DSA approved scope is being completed in this bid package. The trade packages for this scope of work were competitively bid by C.T. Brayton and Sons. The proposed cost was a result of the combined scores of representatives from the District, the Architect of Record and C.T. Brayton and Sons.

The Taft Elementary School HVAC Replacement Project will replace the HVAC systems within the classroom, administration and multipurpose buildings. The work includes related architectural, structural and electrical work as indicated on the drawings. The bids included an additive alternate to address additional ventilation in the Stage area. Also included are allowances for undefined scope as it relates to the replacement of ceiling grid and additional concrete paving.

Bid documents were prepared and advertised in accordance with the law. A breakdown of the bids is as follows:
