DEFINITION

Assist with the planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of State and Federal programs including the Local Education Agency Plan, Single Plans for Student Achievement, the English Learner Master Plan, and Program Improvement initiatives in support of the Blueprint for Student Achievement. Administrator will provide day-to-day programmatic, compliance, and technical support to schools and to various departments of the District; and perform other related duties as assigned.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED AND EXERCISED

Receives direction from the Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum, Instruction, and Categorical Programs, and will support and supervise program support staff as assigned.

Render programmatic and technical assistance to school site staff, parents and students. Support, develop and implement activities and procedures to involve parents.

Organize and conduct in-service workshops for staff and parents in areas related to State and Federal Programs.

Assist in the selection, development and/or recommendation of related curriculum materials to improve and enhance the performance of participating students.

Assist in the coordination and monitoring of the Federal Program Monitoring Review (FPM) to provide assistant to district program and school site leadership teams. **E**

Assist in the investigation and/or review complaints or compliance concerns for the State and Federal Program. E

Assist in the development, monitoring, and evaluation of site based supplemental programs such as AVID, MESA and UCPREP programs.

Perform related duties as assigned.
