### Apply on EdJoin.org/StocktonUSD

- Minimum of 48 college units
- OR Proficiency Exam

#### Proficiency Exam details:

The Proficiency Exam is offered at 8am on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday of each month at the SUSD School for Adults 1525 Pacific Avenue in Stockton.

- Up to 4 hours are allotted to complete the exam
- Contact the School for Adults to schedule an appointment at (209) 933-7455 EXT. 1404 or 1406
- Bring a picture ID and proof of High School completion (diploma or transcript)

## **Exam Preparation:**
