- All services, including professional development should be listed on one budget/price list
  - **Budget.** I see we are to budget per school site and based on 100 students. Can you confirm: Most sites have an average of 100+ students who attend daily. Although all student may not partake in Esports, this is an average number of students we want to consider to provide programming to.
  - How many hours a day to price on (3?) This is not something we share out. Vendors are responsible to be share their cost with us per hour or half a day, as our programs average 3 to 4 hours a day. Our vendors are responsible to be competitive in their bidding.
- 100 students so that would be 5 classes of 20 per site for 180 academic days. Staff to student ratios is 1:20 and this contract will operate through June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Our focus to start shortly after board approval, as early as April through the summer, June 30<sup>th</sup>, or at minimum for the summer time May and June.
