## **Classified Personnel**

The primary role of classified personnel is to support and enhance the efforts of certificated personnel to achieve the purposes and goals of the schools as adopted by the Governing Board.

(cf. 0200 – Goals for the School District)

All personnel policies and regulations pertaining to classified personnel must be written in harmony with that primary role.

Classified services shall consist of all employees in positions not requiring certification. The following positions shall not be considered a part of the classified services: substitute or short-term employees who are employed for less than 75 percent of the school year, part-time playground positions (noon-duty aides), full-time day students employed part-time, apprentices and professional experts employed on a temporary basis for a specific project.
