Magnet Schools/Programs

Establishment Procedures

Magnet schools may be set up, established or designated by the Board of Education upon the recommendation of the Superintendent at new or established schools in the district.

Any school designated as a magnet school shall provide a special Curriculum designed to attract students from throughout the District while providing a complete well-rounded educational program to meet student needs.

The party or parties interested in establishing a magnet school submit a written proposal to the Educational Services Office.

After the proposal is submitted, a meeting with the interested parties and staff of the Educational Services Office will be held to discuss the proposal.

After the above meeting, the Deputy Superintendent will make the recommendation to the Superintendent regarding the proposals.

If denied, the party or parties may appeal the recommendation by submitting a written appeal to the Superintendent.

The Superintendent or his/her designee shall make his/her recommendation to the Board of Education regarding all proposals for establishment of magnet schools.
