School Attendance Boundaries

General Procedures

1. Intradistrict attendance regulations relate to the attendance of Stockton Unified School District pupils in schools located in attendance zones other than those in which they reside.
2. The legal residence of the parent(s) or legal guardian determines entrance into an elementary, middle or high school. There can be only one legal residence. Legal residence may include a regularly established licensed children's institution, or a licensed foster home, or a family home, but the address of a child care provider cannot be used as a legal residence.
3. Students in Stockton Unified School District may attend a school outside their attendance area of residence if space is available. An Intradistrict Open Enrollment Agreement may be requested by the parent or legal guardian and submitted before January 1 for the following school year. (For the 94-95 school year, applications for year round school must be submitted prior to June 1, and applications for all other schools prior to August 1).
