### **Literacy Series**

The F.E.E.O. launched two literacy program series tailored to Latino pre-school parents and African American/ Black parents. Participants were pre-registered through our parent advisory committees as well as through the collaboration of our preschool department. Families received books and materials that go along with the reading and activities for each session.

The Latino Literacy workshop is a 10-week session teaching Latino preschool parents about the importance of reading with their children at an early age. As part of the program, the participants will complete a scrapbook activity.

The Black Literacy workshop is a 7-week session with a featured book each week and an activity focusing on the book topic.
