Mathematics (includes passing Algebra 1-2)	20 credits / 2 years	3 years (“c”) Three years of math through second year Algebra. Four years recommended
Science	20 credits / 2 years One year biological science One year physical science	2 years (“d”) One year biological science One year physical science Three years recommended
Physical Education	20 credits / 2 years	N/A
Visual and Performing Arts	10 credits / 1 year	1 year (“P”) One year from a single area
World Language	10 credits / 1 year	2 years (“e”) Two years of the same language, three years recommended
Electives	70 credits	1 year (“g”) One year of college prep elective
California High School Exit Exam	All tenth grade students must take the CaHSEE in the spring. The test has two parts, reading/writing and math. Must pass both sections	GPA and test scores (SAT or ACT) must meet combined minimum (SAT II required for UC)
