How are schools certified?

At the start of each school year, the AVID site team completes the Coaching and Certification Instrument (CCI) which includes four key domains (Instruction, Systems, Leadership and Culture). Through the year, the CCI guides the team in evaluating the implementation of AVID at the site and documenting school wide progress. Through Professional Learning Communities (PLC's), site teams can encourage the growth of AVID at their school.

The overall AVID certification rating is determined by the AVID Site Team and AVID District Coordinator. The two parties work together to create an individualized timeline to fully develop and sustain the AVID system.

Showcase

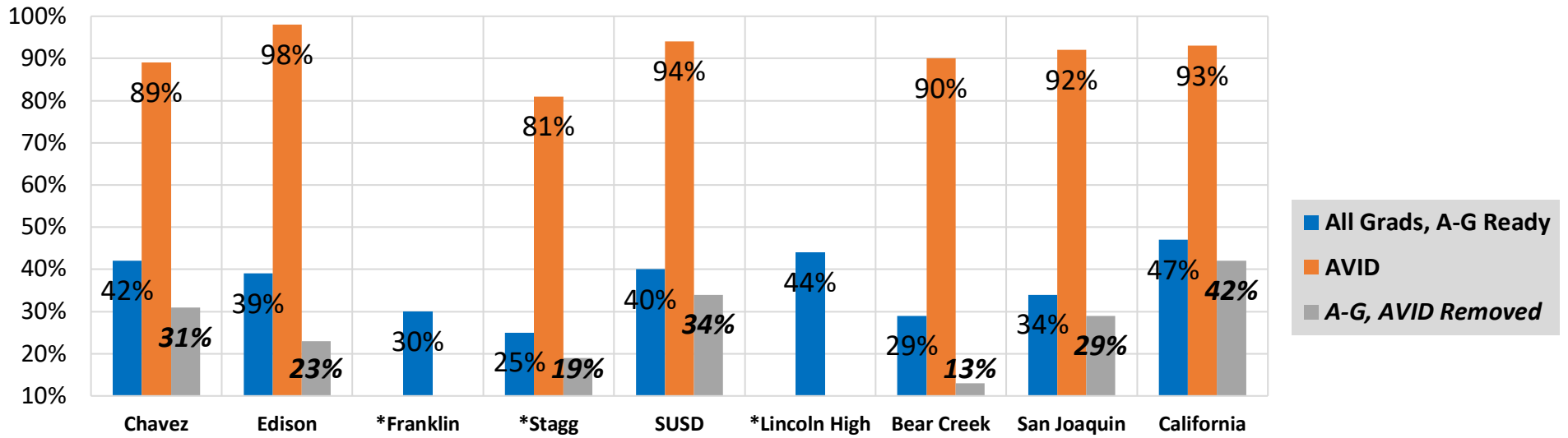

National Demonstration Schools

Centers of teaching and learning that also serve as models for those interested in learning about the AVID College Readiness System. They clearly demonstrate an ongoing pursuit of excellence, both in the AVID elective and AVID schoolwide, to ensure college readiness for all AVID Elective students and improved academic performance for all students based on increased opportunities and support for success.

A National Demonstration School exhibits a college readiness system that is evident across the campus through rigor and high expectations for all students. There is significant evidence of AVID impact schoolwide, particularly with the infusion of AVID methodologies in content-area classrooms.

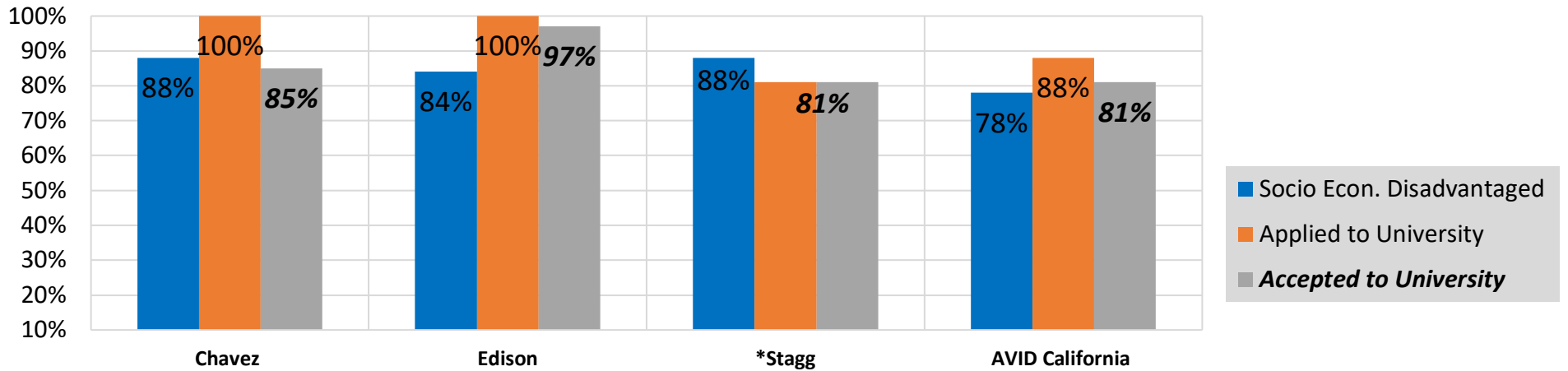
% of Seniors Graduating with A-G College Entrance Requirements, 2016-2017

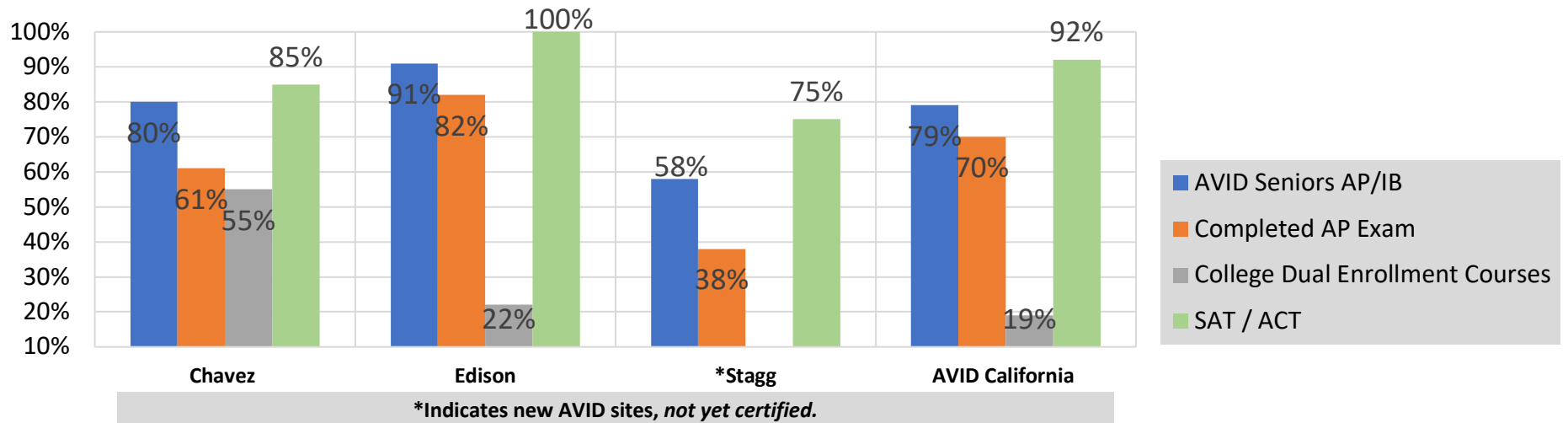
2016-2017 AVID Seniors; Socioeconomic Status and College Acceptance

2016-2017 AVID; Courses of Rigor and Exam Participation

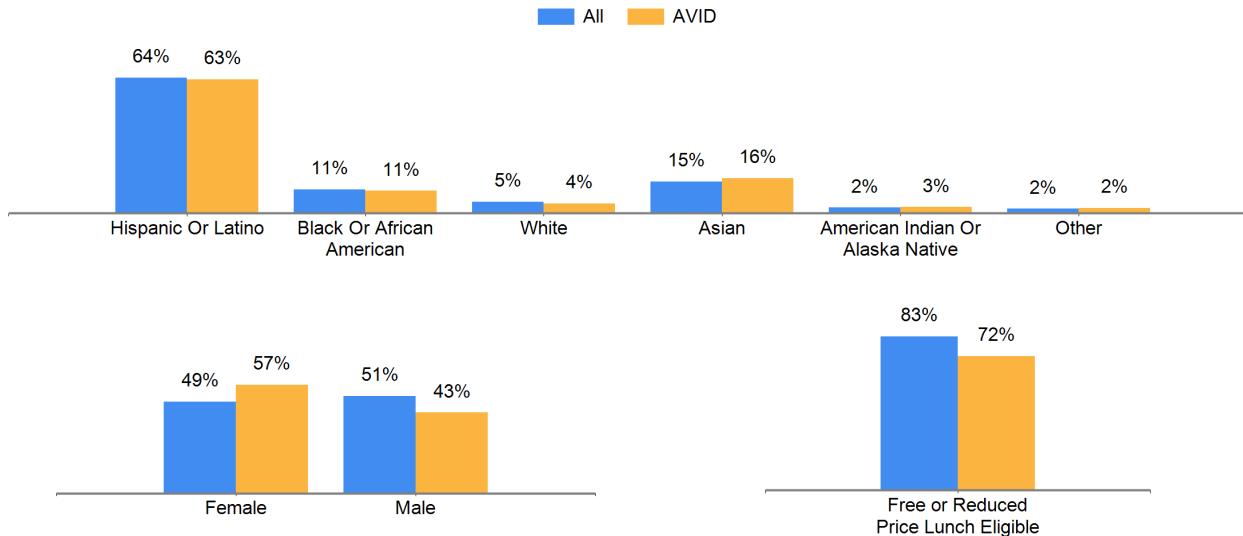
