- **Parent Involvement** -PSAC/ Culture Classes/ Educational Supports-IEP's, SST's,parent conference



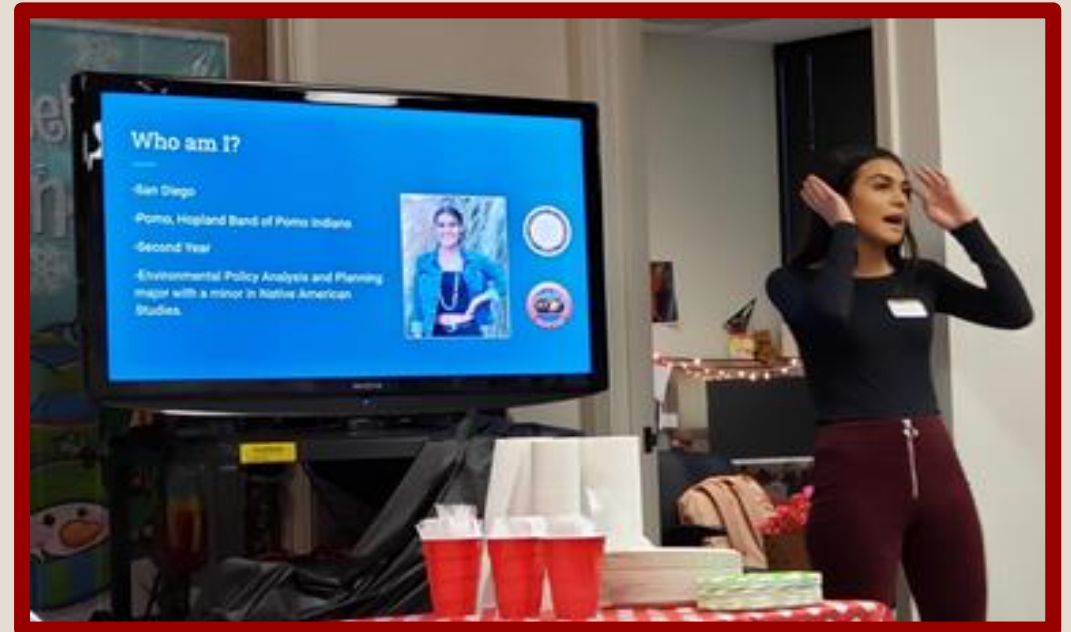
# Objective 2: Increase knowledge of Cultural Identity

# Budget/506 Forms

# Budget -2019-2020

**Total Budget : \$308,000**

◦ **Objective 2 – Increase knowledge of cultural identity**

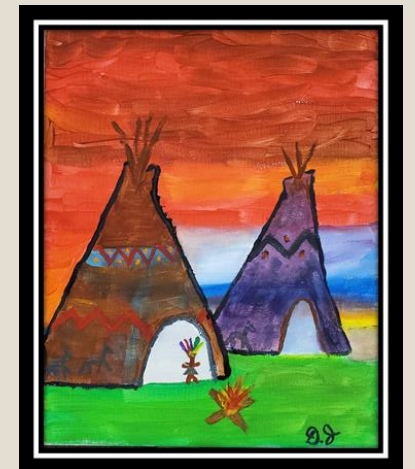

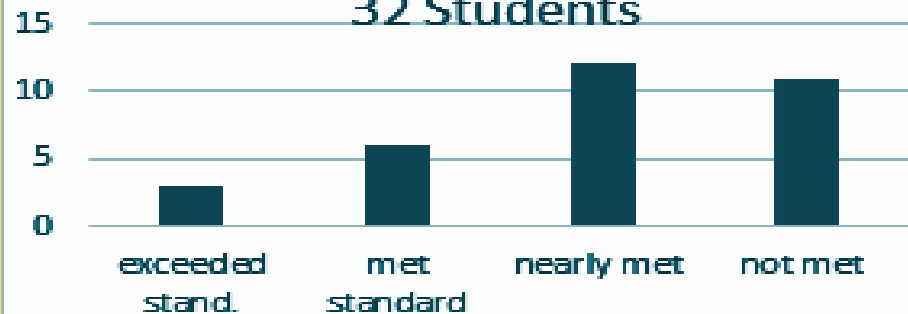

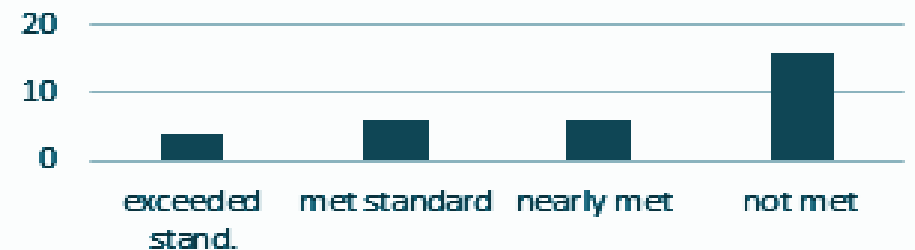

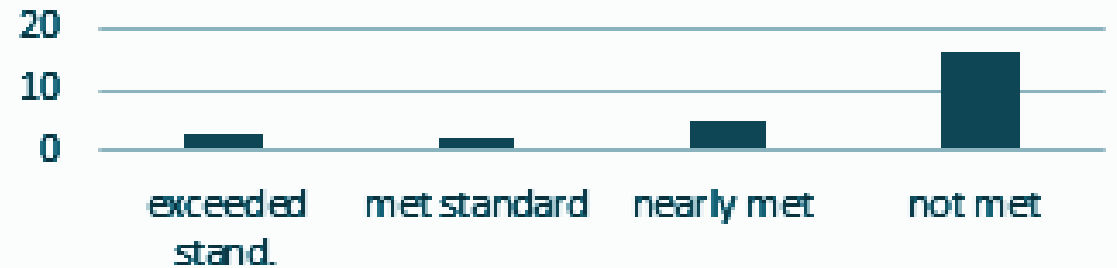

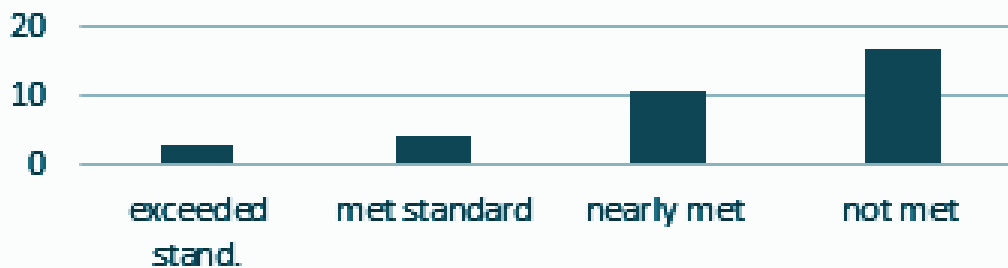

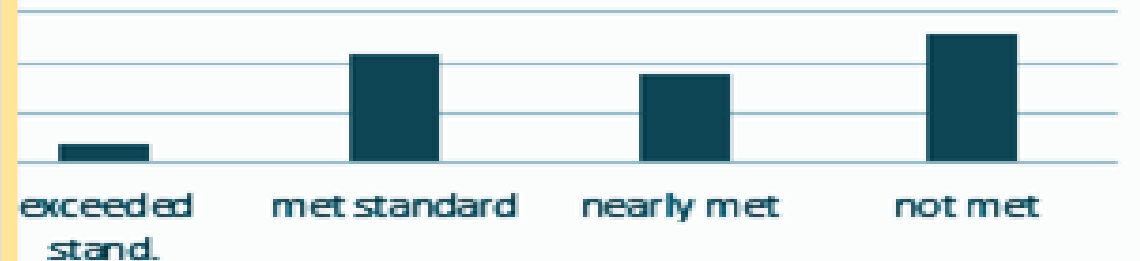

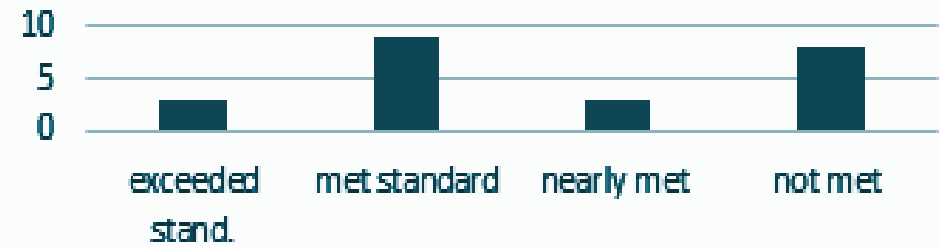

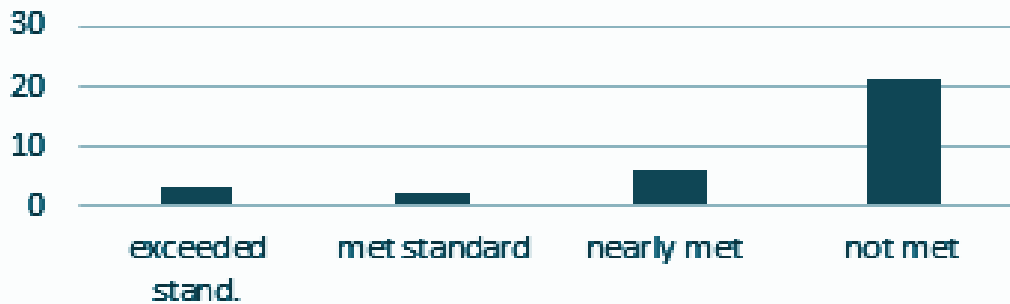

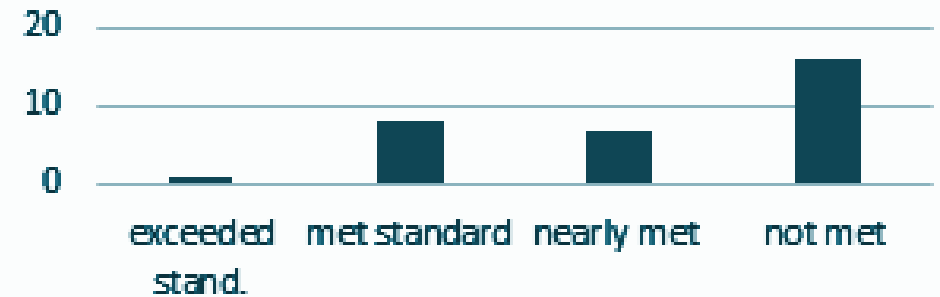
