Gina reported that during the Spring gathering they handed out school supplies, flowers, and vegetables. Destiny added that we also gave out 100 boxes of foods. The Lathrop council woman Minnie Jordan Diallo, the Pow Wow Princess, Delya Martinez, Jackie Montanez, Christina McBrian and Rebecca Lopez volunteered.
