

## Information about School of Choice Schools

Federal law requires that districts offer Choice transfers at least 14 days before the beginning of school. As the State of California releases the AYP information after Stockton Unified schools begin, letters were sent to parents whose children attend a PI school, or a school that might be identified as PI when AYP information is released. Should parents wish to transfer their child to a non-PI school they may select from the following schools and their application will be taken into consideration.

- Elementary: Nightingale, Pittman, and Taylor
- High School: Health Careers Academy, Pacific Law Academy, Edward C. Merlo Institute of Environmental Technology, Stockton Early College Academy and Stockton High School (Grades 9-12)
