Classtime

School starts at 7:30a.m. The students will have work to do upon entering the classroom. If your child is tardy or absent on a regular basis he/she will quickly fall behind academically. Please be prompt picking up your child. Kindergarten is dismissed at 1:25p.m. Parents or Guardians will come to room 6 and pick them up every day. Students that are not picked up on time will be taken to the office.

Classwork and Homework

Your child will bring home their classwork daily. Please remove it from their backpack and review it with them. Students will also bring home a homework (ziploc) bag with homework. I recommend you assist your child with the homework but please do not do it for him/her. The homework bag is to come to school every day with the homework. Soon it will also contain a take home book for nightly reading. Friday Folders will also be going home in a couple of weeks.

Supplies

The school and I have provided most classroom supplies. You will need to supply your child with a backpack and home supplies (pencil, crayons, scissors, glue) to complete their homework. Periodically, a note will be sent home requesting donations of items such as hand sanitizer, glue sticks, tissue and treats. Your assistance at those times would be greatly appreciated.

Volunteers

Family members are encouraged to volunteer in the classroom. You can assist with preparing materials, tutoring individual children, and/or helping with a planned activity. Your help is greatly needed and absolutely appreciated. However, you must have a current negative TB test and have been fingerprinted to work with the students.

If your child's birthday falls during the school year, and you would like to celebrate, you may bring chips and punch or cupcakes and water for the entire class to enjoy, please contact me two days in advance. **Please remember that any food brought for the entire class has to be store bought and still sealed within the wrapper that you brought it in.**
