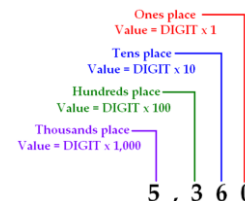
Wednesday – students can keep practicing at home on i-Ready and with the extra math homework I sent home**
