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Frequently Asked Questions

Who can participate?

Classes that missed out on Science Camp last year or would have gone to Camp this year.

What about 7th graders, who missed last year because of the cancellations, can they attend?

Yes, we will have special openings for 7th graders but only for schools that were canceled due to COVID-19. Virtual lessons are aligned with 7th grade NGSS.

How far in advance can we schedule the virtual science camp?

Reservations are taken up to 3 months in advance. As we assess current reopening guidelines, we will open more months for reserving.

Will the virtual lessons target a specific grade?

Yes, lessons will be specific to 5th or 6th grade and will be aligned with NGSS.

What is the schedule?

Teachers will submit their reservations and choose:

- Preferred week
- Days of the week: Mon./Tue./Wed.; Tue./Wed./Thu.; or Wed./Thu./Fri.
- Time blocks for the 45 minutes 1 hour lessons: Early Morning Block (8-10am), Mid-morning Block (10am-12pm), or Early Afternoon Block (12:30pm-2:30pm)

Can all the 5th or 6th grade students from our school attend during the same week?

Yes, our goal is to schedule schools with multiple classes during the same week if this is their preference. However, to ensure this accommodation we will need each teacher to submit a separate reservation. Since registration is electronic we suggest one teacher submit all the separate registrations at one time to keep your classes together.
