Yearly Graduation



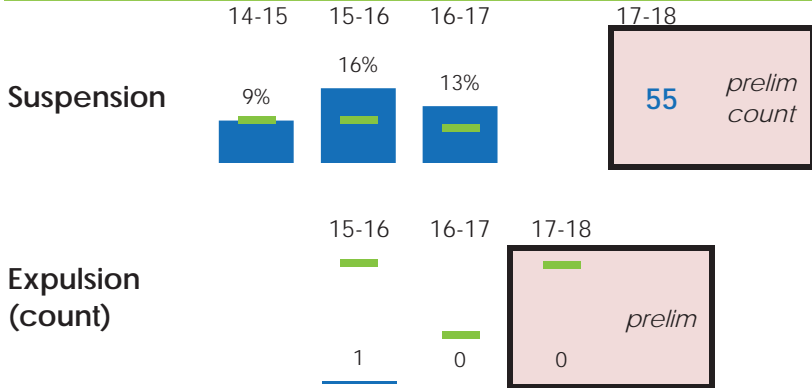

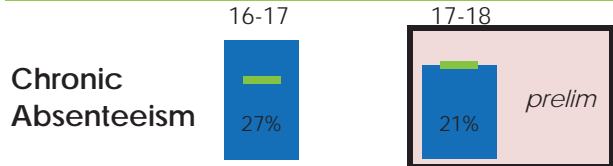

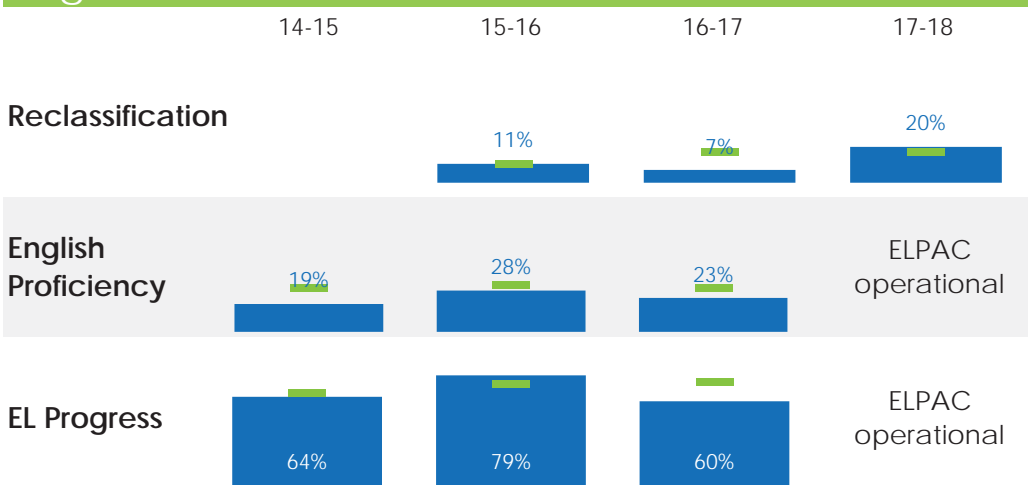
