## IB Coordinator's Corner

Hello Falcon Families,

Knowledge is one of the five essential elements of the IB Primary Years Program. Our teachers develop the Units of Inquiry from IB's Transdisciplinary Themes. These themes are based on global topics that address issues that humanity faces. When we plan our lessons around these themes, we ask what do we want students to know? Our Units of Inquiries (UOI) are on concepts that apply anywhere in the world. Along with teaching those concepts, we are also responsible for teaching subjects such as Math, English Language Arts, Science, Social Studies, Arts, and Physical Education. We incorporate these subject areas into the UOIs as much as possible to make students' learning as meaningful as possible. When a subject area does not fit into the UOIs, we call that a Stand Alone unit and make sure it is taught on its own.

This week's IB Family Meeting focuses on two very important tests your child will take. All of our students take the MAP tests and grades 3-5 students take the state test called SBAC. Please join us to learn about these two tests on Wednesday, November 8, 2017 at 8:15 am OR Thursday, November 9, 2017 at 5:00 pm.

Nuestros profesores desarrollan las Unidades de Investigación de los Temas Transdisciplinarios del IB. Estos temas se basan en temas globales que abordan los problemas que enfrenta la humanidad. Cuando planificamos nuestras lecciones en torno a estos temas, nos preguntamos ¿qué queremos que los alumnos sepan? Nuestras unidades de investigación (UOI) se basan en conceptos que se aplican en cualquier parte del mundo. Además de enseñar esos conceptos, también somos responsables de enseñar materias tales como Matemáticas, Artes del Lenguaje Inglés, Ciencias, Estudios Sociales, Artes y Educación Física. Incorporamos estas áreas temáticas en los UOI tanto como sea posible para que el aprendizaje de los estudiantes sea lo más significativo posible. Cuando un área temática no encaja en los UOI, la llamamos una unidad independiente y nos aseguramos de que se enseñe por sí misma.


