
#### **IB Coordinator's Corner**

#### Hello PYA Families.

The staff here at PYA have been preparing for our upcoming evaluation in January. After being authorized, the International Baccalaureate Organization conducts evaluation visits to their world schools every four to five years. To prepare for this visit, we spent the last year working on our Self Study. The Self Study is a process where we take a look at the progress we are making on the IB Standards and rating how well we are doing that job. We have spent a little over a year analyzing our work, recognizing where we are doing well and where we need to grow. From this process, we have selected goals for our Action Plan. The Action Plan is an annual document that lists goals for the year and our plan to achieve those goals. We will continue to post information on the evaluation process as we move closer to January. 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
