

When Should My Application Be Submitted?

- Applications for the 2023-2024 school year will be accepted from **October 1, 2022** through **May 26, 2023**.
- If the number of potential enrollees exceeds the capped enrollment limit +10%, a public lottery will be held to ensure equity in placement.
- Applications received <u>after May 26, 2023</u> can be accommodated only until the capped enrollment limit for each class is reached. At that point, all additional enrollment requests will be placed on a waiting list and subject to a lottery process.
