NOTIFICATION OF POTENTIAL COVID-19 EXPOSURE

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Your student has potentially been exposed to an individual at school that tested positive for COVID-19. Please follow the guidelines below:

Students and individuals that have been exposed to COVID-19 must do the following:

- If your child was exposed and is **fully vaccinated (2 COVID-19 vaccine doses) and asymptomatic (no symptoms)**, they may stay in school and will not need to get tested.
- If your child was exposed and is **not fully vaccinated and remains asymptomatic**, they may stay in school, with the recommendation to get tested in 3 – 5 days in order to mitigate the potential for further spread. Testing is not mandated at this time, however, we recommend that students are tested.
- If your child is involved in extracurricular activities (sports, bands, clubs etc.) they may continue participating in these activities as long as they remain asymptomatic. If they were exposed at school, we recommend they test within 3 – 5 days from exposure to ensure the safety of all team or group member.

As a reminder, if your child is experiencing symptoms of illness and/or if they test positive for COVID-19, please keep them home from school, contact your school and follow isolation guidance.

Those who are **symptomatic** will be isolated and sent home. Please note that for those that test positive, isolation can now end after Day 5 if symptoms are not present or are resolving and your student test's negative on Day 5 or later.
