The award will be made to one deserving female high school senior to cover educational cost up to and not to exceed \$500 total. The award is targeted to honor a female senior, who exhibits personal integrity and excellence through academic achievement and community involvement, and demonstrates a moderate to significant need for financial assistance in attaining her educational goals. The recipient may complete her undergraduate studies in the field of her choice at an accredited four-year college or university of her choice. The Omega Kappa Zeta chapter, Scholarship Committee, of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorporated will review the applications and select the most worthy recipient of this award. The award recipient(s) will be chronicled on the Omega Kappa Zeta Chapter website and Zeta social media platforms.

Amount

\$500 to aid the cost of tuition, books, or related expenses.

Eligibility Requirements

• Must have been a female graduate from a high school in San Joaquin or East Contra Costa counties, in May/June 2022.

• Must be enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited college or university in the fall of the same year.

• Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale and demonstrate financial need.

• Community service and involvement is a plus.

Affiliation with any members of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorporated or any of its auxiliary organizations is not a requirement.

Due by April 30, 2022. Applications and support documents received after this date will not be considered for award.

Scholarship Application Instructions

All scholarship applications must include the application, the goal statement, personal essay, two (2) letters of recommendation and transcripts to be considered for an award. Official due upon receipt of award.

All submissions must be complete at the time of submission. NO partial submissions will be accepted. All submissions must be emailed in one PDF to:

Legal Name

Please use your legal name. Do not use nicknames. Make sure your name is consistent throughout your submission. The name that appears on your official transcript should match your application and letters of recommendation.

Transcripts

Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc., Omega Kappa Zeta Chapter accepts official transcripts that are stamped with an official school seal and signed by an authorized school administrator in a PDF format.

Letters of Recommendation

All letters of recommendation need to be addressed to the Omega Kappa Zeta Finer Womanhood Scholarship Committee. Letters of recommendation addressed to other individuals and/or other organizations will not be accepted and will be denied. Letters of recommendation need to clearly state that the letter is recommending the applicant's legal name for the Finer Womanhood Scholarship. Letters of recommendation need to be reflective of activities and accomplishments within a reasonable time frame. Letters of recommendation should be current, within nine months of your application submission.

Application Deadline

All submissions are due on or before April 30, 2022 in one electronic submission; this includes the application, essay, goal statement, letters of recommendation and official transcripts. Please plan to collect your documentation and email your submission accordingly. Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc., Omega Kappa Zeta Chapter will not accept electronic submissions received after April 30, 2022.

GOAL STATEMENT (Must be typewritten 300 words maximum)

The applicant must describe her future career goals and how receiving this scholarship award will help achieve those goals. The goals statement should not be longer than 300 words, on a separate page clearly titled, "Goal(s) Statement".

PERSONAL ESSAY (Must be typewritten, two (2) pages maximum)

On a separate page clearly titled "Personal Essay".

Students must show that they are committed to continuing their education by maintaining high academic and personal achievement. This essay is your opportunity to tell us about yourself and explain why you should be selected to receive this scholarship. Your written essay should clearly demonstrate experiences or accomplishments in at least **three (3)** of the **five (5)** areas listed below:

Special Talent: Discuss a special attribute or accomplishment that sets you apart from your peers. Examples may include, but are not limited to: working well with others, artistic talents, athletic ability, public speaking or writing skills, a creative activity/challenge that you engaged in, etc.

Leadership and Service: Clearly articulate how you have demonstrated your leadership ability both in and out of school. Examples may include, but are not limited to: community service involvement, leadership roles or unique responsibilities at home, school or church, etc.

Challenges: Describe how you have achieved a goal despite struggles or obstacles that may have hindered you. Be specific. Examples may include, but are not limited to: achievement of a goal despite struggles or barriers, withstanding significant peer pressure(s) that may have otherwise deterred your achievements, overcoming a major life event, etc.

Influences: Discuss situations or persons that have been major influences in your life. Examples may include, but are not limited to: how your personal background has affected your view of the world, an individual or group who has been your biggest influence and why, a book that has affected you deeply and why, etc.

Financial Need: Provide a more detailed and personal account of your financial need. You may describe, from a financial standpoint, what impact would this award would have on your education, or share any special circumstances affecting your need for financial assistance.

LETTERS OF REFERENCE

Two (2) Reference letters from any of the following sources: Teacher, School Counselor, Church, Community Leader. Letters from relatives are not acceptable references for this application. Contact information for each reference must be included.

OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT

Unofficial transcripts will be accepted with the application, however an official transcript is required in order to release scholarship funds.
