Rotary Club of Stockton Frank Thornton Smith Music Scholarship

The Frank Thornton Smith Music Scholarship is awarded each year to promising music students graduating from a Stockton high school who are planning to attend San Joaquin Delta College or a four-year college or university majoring in music. Delta College students transferring to a four-year accredited college or university are also eligible for the award.

The process for consideration is the completion of the Frank Thornton Smith Application for Music Scholarship Audition and a written essay (maximum 500 words) on his/her career objectives, love of music, or some other musical topic that will share some of the student's passion for music.

Each application must also include two letters of reference (see application for details) and a current school transcript attached to the original application. When completed, these should be mailed to the following:

After initial screening, qualifying candidates will be contacted to schedule and audition and personal interview (both done during the same appointment). Students will be contacted by phone to arrange the audition if they qualify.

Audition Guidelines:

- The audition will be conducted in the front of a panel of judges.
- You will need three copies of your audition piece available.
- Selected audition piece cannot be longer than 15 minutes in length.
- Singers will need to supply their own accompaniment.

This scholarship is not based on need. The award requires that the recipient have a 3.0 grade point average (GPA) or better on a 4.0 scale at the time of application, verifiable by his/her current transcript.

Requirements and guidelines for Scholarship Payment:

- The award will be paid in semester installments upon verification of enrollment as a music major in any accredited four-year college or university (or Delta College for high school graduates) within the United States and after receipt of student tuition and fee payment requirements.
- The recipient must be a full-time student (12 credit hours/units minimum) and have attained a 2.5 GPA or better on a 4.0 scale at the end of the first semester, in order to be eligible for the second semester payment.

- Documentation must be received at the above address by October 15 (first semester) and March 15 (second semester) otherwise the designated scholarship money will be awarded to new scholarship applicants.
- The award monies will be paid directly to the institution in the name of the recipient and can only be used for tuition, instructional fees, and or books.

Under no circumstances may the money go directly to the student. Stockton Rotary Endowment will require sufficient documentation from the educational institution to ensure that the funds have been appropriately used.

The award presentation will be made at one of the weekly meetings of the Stockton Rotary Club.

All applications must be received by January 31, 2020 to be considered.

Guidelines for Payment:

- The award will be paid in two installments:
 - FIRST installment will be paid upon receipt of documentation of enrollment as a full-time student in any accredited two* or four-year college or university within the United States. The recipient must be a full-time student (12 credit hours/units minimum) each semester. The deadline for submission of documentation for the first semester is October 15.
 - SECOND installment will be paid upon receipt of documentation of proof
 of enrollment for the second semester plus proof of having attained a 2.5
 GPA or better on a 4.0 scale at the end of the first semester of attendance.
 The deadline for submission of documentation for the second semester
 is March 15.

The award monies will be paid directly to the institution in the name of the recipient and can only be used for tuition, institutional fees, or books. Under no circumstances may the money go directly to the student. The Stockton Rotary Club will request sufficient documentation from the educational institution to ensure that the funds have been appropriately used.

It is the responsibility of the recipient to see that proper documentation is submitted to the Treasurer of the Rotary Club of Stockton in a timely manner. If the award is not given out due to a lack of documentation submission in a timely manner, the Rotary Club of Stockton reserves the right to award another student. Submitted NO LATER THAN October 15 of first semester and March 15 of second semester.

In the event that the student attends a two-year community college, the award is for the cost of books, fees, and tuition up to the awarded amount and not the singular dollar amount as the community college charges may be less than the award.
