- 1. Character
- 2. Academics
- 3. Athletics/Performing Arts
- 4. Extracurricular Activities
- 5. Congressional Nomination (Congress, Senator, Vice President, Presidential)
- 6. Candidate Fitness Assessment
- 7. Recommendation Letters (English, Math, Science, Athletic Director)
- 8. Summer Programs (except Merchant Marine)-Summer after 11th

Tips

- 1. Complete Application (As early as possible)
- 2. Ask for Letters of Recommendation early
- 3. Get in touch with your teachers and school counselors (Character)
- 4. Build a resume (Awards, academic achievements, work experience)
- 5. Apply for ROTC: Reserved Officer Training Corps
- 6. Connect with High School and Academy Counselors
- 7. Practice your interviews-Why do you want to attend?


High School Timeline

9th grade: High grades, SAT/ACT Practice, clubs, Attending Informational Session

10th: AP classes, SAT Prep, PSAT's, involved in clubs, community service

11th: Toughest classes, applying for summer programs, officers of clubs, ask for recommendation letters, Reach out to Congressman for Congressional nominations, Senator and Vice Presidential nominations, look at websites for academies. Summer Academies, Physical Assessment, Resume

12th: Application completed by August-January



at West Point 9

All are required to be U.S. citizens



Aged between 17 and 23 years old.



West Point cadets must be unmarried, not pregnant and not under obligation to support any children.







Above-average high school or college academic records, and good scores on either the ACT or SAT tests are also expected.



Physical Aptitude Examination: 300-yard run, two minutes of push-ups, a standing long jump, a basketball throw from a kneeling position and pull-ups.
