9°: grados superiores, práctica SAT / ACT, asistencia a la sesión informativa

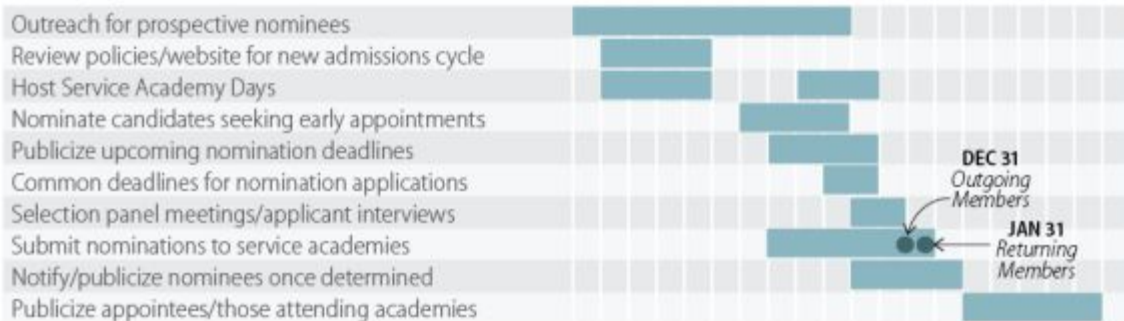
10°: clases AP, preparación para el SAT, PSAT, participación en clubes, servicio comunitario

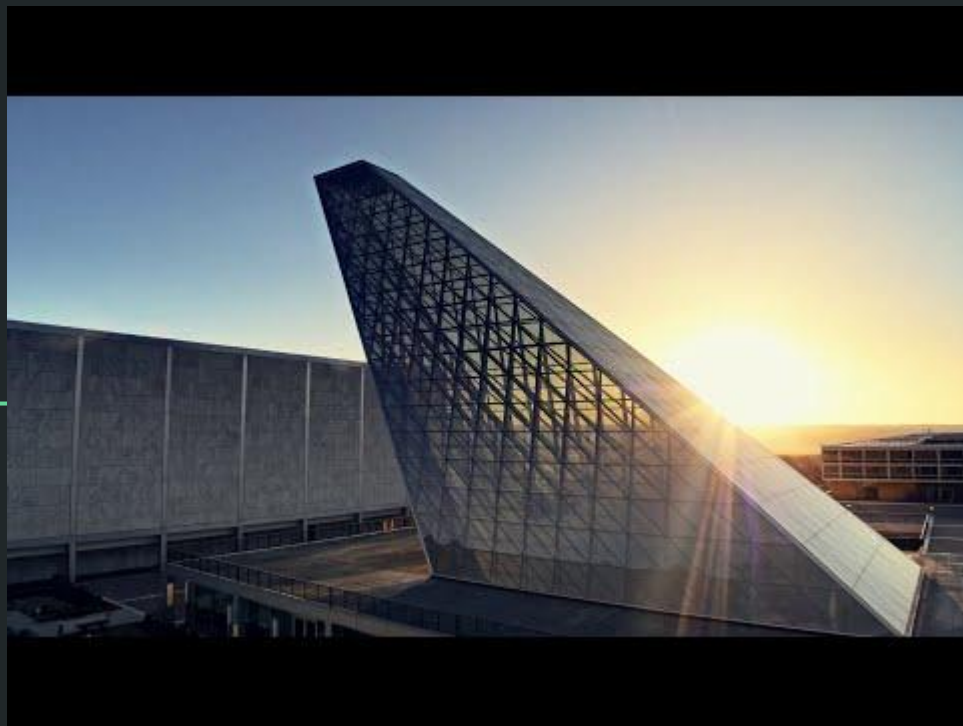

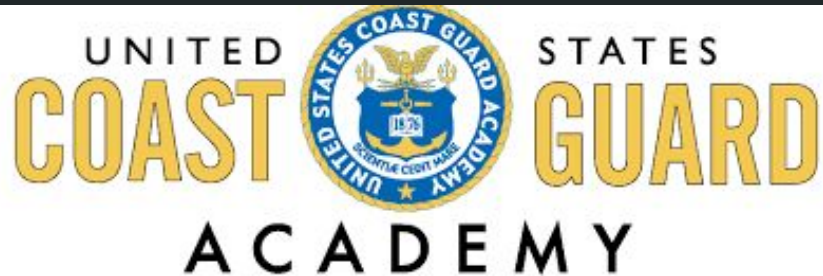

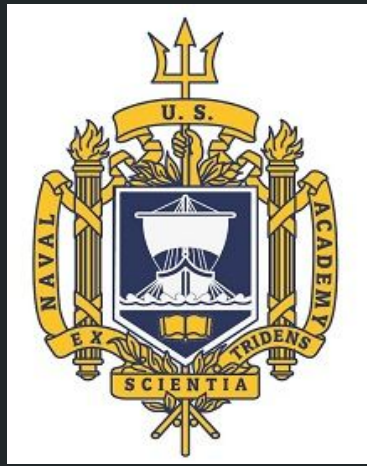
