

STOCKTON UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT SEEKS MEMBERS TO SERVE ON A CITIZENS' BOND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

Stockton Unified School District (SUSD) is seeking local citizens interested in serving on the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC) for the Stockton Unified School District

WHAT IS A CITIZENS' BOND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE?

After a bond measure is approved by voters, the SUSD Board of Education is legally required to appoint a Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee. This committee consists of dedicated volunteers who will actively review the spending of bond funds by the school district and report their findings to the Board of Education and the public.

WHAT DOES THE CITIZENS' BOND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE DO?

The CBOC is actively involved in assuring the community that the bond funds spent by SUSD are for projects that were approved by voters. The committee annually reports its findings to the Board of Education, including both positive observations and areas that need improvement.

WHAT IS THE COMMITMENT OF A MEMBER?

Members are appointed for a two-year term and the committee meets one or two times per year.

WHAT ARE THE DUTIES OF A MEMBER?

- To actively monitor all project expenditures
- To provide oversight and accountability, ensuring that bond funds are spent only on projects that were approved by voters
- To report to the Board of Education and members of the community on the progress and expenditures of bond funds

NOTE: No employee, board member, vendor, contractor or consultant of the District can be appointed to the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee.
