- The first application period will be from January 25, 2020 through February 7, 2020. Applications must be postmarked by February 7, 2020, received via mail or online by 5:00 pm on February 7, 2020.
- The second application period will be from April 1-May 25, 2020. Applications must be postmarked by May 25, 2020, received via mail or online by 5:00 pm on May 25, 2020
- A list of names of the students participating in the random selection process will be posted in the Central Enrollment Center for public inspection twenty-four (24) hours prior to the selection process. The Specialty Schools first round lottery will be held on Friday, March 13, 2020 in the SUSD Board room at 701 North Madison Street commencing at 9:00 am. Parents will be notified of Lottery School placement beginning April 3, 2020. The second round lottery will be held on June 11, 2020 in in the SUSD Board room at 701 North Madison Street commencing at 9:00 a.m. Parents will be notified of second round Lottery School placement beginning July 13, 2020.
- Applications received after the deadlines, will NOT be placed in the random selection process but will be placed on a waiting list in the order received until October 1, 2020. All waiting lists will expire after October 1, 2020.
- Incomplete applications cannot be processed. All information must be provided. Incomplete applications are not eligible for the random selection process and are invalid.
- Falsification of information on the application will invalidate the application as well as any resulting student placement.
- If the random selection process results in a student placement in a requested program, he/she will be removed from all other waiting lists.
- Applicants will be notified of their standing as the result of the random selection process via mail.
- Upon notification by mail of a student's placement in a program, the parent/guardian must confirm the placement by registering at the Central Enrollment Center for Specialty Schools. All enrollments must be completed within the timeline in the letter. If no confirmation is made, the placement will be cancelled and the student application will be removed from the waiting list.
- It is the obligation of the parent/guardian to inform the district of all changes to applicant's address or telephone number.
- The district does not provide transportation for school of choice.
