**Stockton Unified School District
 Secondary Open Enrollment**

Open Enrollment Dates: Begins on January 29 and ends at 5:00 p.m. on February 28, 2020

Open Enrollment offers students an opportunity to attend schools outside of their attendance area. Open enrollment schools have attendance boundaries and priority will be given to students who live within their assigned school boundaries. Admittance to the school of your choice under the Open Enrollment process is done by a random lottery system. *The results of the lottery will be sent via US mail at the end of March 2020.*

The school accepting the student under the open enrollment process becomes the student’s school of attendance for the duration of the time that the student remains at any grade level offered at that school.

Once a student is accepted and attending the school of choice the student may be subject to displacement if they fail to comply with the following guidelines:

- Maintain a satisfactory record of daily attendance.
- Comply with all state laws and school and District rules and regulations with regard to student discipline.
- Maintain a satisfactory record of academic progress.

Students who wish to return to their neighborhood school must reapply during the open enrollment period.

Some grade levels may be impacted due to class size limitations and space availability in our schools, this may impact the number of approved applications.

NOTE: You do not need to participate in Open Enrollment if you would like your student to attend the high school serving your regular attendance area.

Each school will be holding information nights for families to learn more about their individual programs. The list of schools and dates are listed below:
