Sonoma State is located in Rohnert Park, CA. Out of 100 people who apply, there are 92 who make it. The acceptance rate at Sonoma State is about 95%, but you need at least a GPA of 3.4. The cost at the university for housing and food is about \$7,000. This university offers many degrees such as health, Art, and Woman Studies. Sonoma State has some cool events like Tuesday Night Trivia. They also offer sports like soccer and baseball. The grants they provide are Counseling, Business, and much more. Overall, the tuition would be about \$9,776 off-campus and \$16,802 on-campus.








