Workshop Facilitator (3)

Through **Stockton Master Innovators**, a diverse youth corps of 25 change agents, we recognize young leaders' incredible potential to shape and lead innovative, breakthrough solutions to problems they experience or witness in their world. We engage with young leaders to support them in their journey to become change agents. We are looking for Facilitators who are passionate about teaching and facilitating rich learning experiences where youth leaders can thrive.

Purpose:

As a Facilitator, you will be part of a team of moderators facilitating discussions and delivering pre-designed content through in-person workshops. The Facilitators will play an integral role in setting expectations, shaping the culture and ensuring youth leaders emerge from the program with the skills and knowledge to drive change in their communities.

Time Commitment:

- Facilitate workshops approximately once a month on weekends from September 2019 to July 2020 (See Key Dates and Timing below).
- Workshops will run from Friday to Sunday with full days on Friday and Saturday and a half day on Sunday.
- You might spend a full day per workshop preparing to facilitate the discussion. Preparation could include reviewing facilitation notes, reading materials (like articles) that are part of the discussion, and reviewing any assignments submitted by students.

Responsibilities:

- Facilitate/co-facilitate discussions on workshop topics that are part of the Master innovators curriculum; workshops occur approximately once a month throughout the yearlong program.
- Support students to reflect on and grow their leadership skills
- Ensure students walk away from each workshop with a deep understanding of the content, inspired and curious to learn more and take on new perspectives
- Create an environment rich in dialogue such that students expand their knowledge and thinking on the topics presented
- Provide guidance to students as they launch pilots
- Build rapport with young leaders as their go-to person for leadership questions and critical thinking
- Support youth to gain confidence and courage to exceed goals and affirm their ability to do the work

Supports:

You will be provided with:

- All curricular materials, facilitation notes, handouts, slides, assignments and readings
- Partnership with the Cambiar team as you prepare to facilitate workshop discussions
- A \$7,500 stipend to facilitate discussions from September 2019 to July 2020
