Walkways	 Voice level 1-2. Respect property of school, self & others. Use kind words and actions. No profanity. Walk quietly up the ramps. 	 Stay to the right in walkways when in groups. Move from area to area promptly. Use our ramps properly without playing on them or cutting through the rails. 	 Keep your hands and feet to yourself. Walking only. Walk properly on the ramps.
Cafeteria	 Voice level 3. Use manners, by saying please and thank you. Use kind words and actions. No profanity. Food is not to be thrown or played with. 	 Wait patiently. Sit in your assigned area. Raise your hand if you need to get up for something. Clean up the area around you. 	 Your food is not to be shared with others. Leave the cafeteria when your bench is dismissed. Walk out of the cafeteria and down the ramp safely. Cup of noodles not permitted. Only milk, water and juice for drinking. SPECIAL PRIVILEGES MAY BE TAKEN AWAY IF RULES ARE NOT FOLLOWED.
Restrooms	 Properly wear your mask indoors at all times. Voice level 1-2. Knock on stall doors before going in. Give others privacy. Use kind words and actions. No profanity. 	 Keep restroom area neat and clean. Flush toilet. Wash hands with soap. Paper towels go in trash can. Toilet paper is not wasted. Toilet paper goes in the toilet after use. Return to your area promptly and quietly. 	 Keep your hands and feet to yourself. Do not block or hold doors closed. Restroom areas are not for eating, playing, climbing or "hanging out "with friends.
Playground	 Voice level up to 5. Take turns when using equipment. Play safely and fairly. Use kind words and actions. No profanity. 	 Do not bring play equipment from home. Keep playground clean and free of litter. Be aware of activities, PE classes or other games around you. Return to play area after using restrooms. The bark area is not for running or playing tag. STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO SELL ANYTHING ON CAMPUS UNLESS APPROVED BY THE PRINCIPAL.	 Bark area is not for running or playing tag. Keep your hands and feet to yourself. Do not throw things at one another. Rough-housing/play fighting is not allowed. Do not speak to others who are outside the fence INCLUDING OUTSIDE VENDORS. Follow all playground equipment rules. Let a supervisor know if any equipment goes outside the fence.

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	Be Responsible & Safe	Consequences
Cell phones	 Students must have a signed permission slip on file in office before bringing a cell phone to school. Cell phones are turned in to the office or teacher daily. If turning the cell phone in to the teacher, the phone must be stored securely. If the cell phone is not turned in to the teacher or office and it is confiscated by an adult during the school day, a parent must pick it from the office. This is counted as a strike. 	 ◆Three-Strike Policyif there are 3 incidents of mis-use, the student will not be allowed to bring a cell phone to school. Incidents include: ✓ Having a cell phone at school without a permission slip. ✓ Having a cell phone at school without turning it in to the teacher or the office.
Dress Code	NOT TO BE WORN AT SCHOOL Baggy or saggy pants that expose underwear and must constantly be pulled up. Pants with holes and rips above your mid-thigh or with holes and rips exposing underwear. Slippers, pajamas, blankets. Tank tops or underwear shirts. Short shorts/short skirts, shorter than mid-thigh (see illustration). Backless blouses, see-through tops. Clothing that exposes your stomach. Strapless or tube tops. Off shoulder tops without shoulder straps. Excessively low cut tops. Halter tops. Spaghetti strap tops. Tops with bra straps showing. Spiked jewelry. Flip flops.	 Call home for a change of clothes. If parent unable to be contacted, student will have a one day pass unless clothing is unsafe or offensive. Student sent home to change clothes. If student is warned 3 times about inappropriate clothing there will be another level consequence.
	 Hats, caps, earmuffs are fine for outdoor weather protection only. Remove your head covering when in the classroompull down your hoodies. Red apparel is prohibited. (NO ALL RED shoelaces, shoes, belts, shirts, shorts, pants, jackets, sweaters, sweatshirts, handkerchiefs, dresses, skirts, etc). Clothing with symbols affiliated with illegal activities including drugs, alcohol, tobacco, violence or with Old English lettering. Clothing or jewelry with symbols of hate, sex, racist groups, prejudice, gangs, obscene language or gestures.
