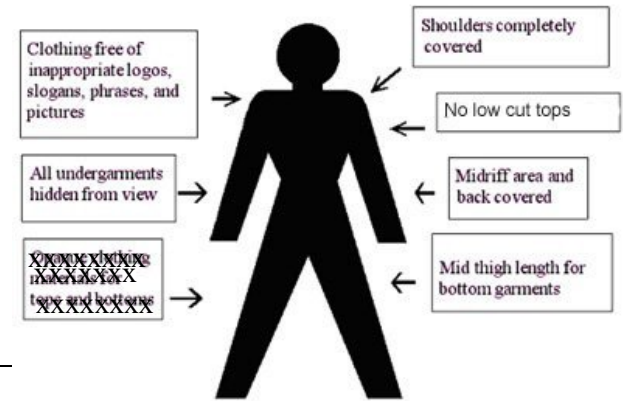
## School-Wide Procedures for Positive Behavior

	<b>Be Respectful</b>	<b>Be Responsible</b>	<b>Be Safe</b>
<b>Walkways</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Voice level 1-2.</li> <li>● Respect property of school, self &amp; others.</li> <li>● Use kind words and actions.</li> <li>● No profanity.</li> <li>● Walk quietly up the ramps.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Stay to the right in walkways when in groups.</li> <li>● Move from area to area promptly.</li> <li>● Use our ramps properly without playing on them or cutting through the rails.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Keep your hands and feet to yourself.</li> <li>● Walking only.</li> <li>● Walk properly on the ramps.</li> </ul>
<b>Cafeteria</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Voice level 3.</li> <li>● Use manners, by saying please and thank you.</li> <li>● Use kind words and actions.</li> <li>● No profanity.</li> <li>● Food is not to be thrown or played with.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Wait patiently.</li> <li>● Sit in your assigned area.</li> <li>● Raise your hand if you need to get up for something.</li> <li>● Clean up the area around you.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Your food is not to be shared with others.</li> <li>● Leave the cafeteria when your bench is dismissed.</li> <li>● Walk out of the cafeteria and down the ramp safely.</li> <li>● Cup of noodles not permitted.</li> <li>● Only milk, water and juice for drinking.</li> </ul> <p>SPECIAL PRIVILEGES MAY BE TAKEN AWAY IF RULES ARE NOT FOLLOWED.</p>
<b>Restrooms</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Properly wear your mask indoors at all times.</li> <li>● Voice level 1-2.</li> <li>● Knock on stall doors before going in.</li> <li>● Give others privacy.</li> <li>● Use kind words and actions.</li> <li>● No profanity.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Keep restroom area neat and clean.</li> <li>● Flush toilet. Wash hands with soap.</li> <li>● Paper towels go in trash can.</li> <li>● Toilet paper is not wasted.</li> <li>● Toilet paper goes in the toilet after use.</li> <li>● Return to your area promptly and quietly.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Keep your hands and feet to yourself.</li> <li>● Do not block or hold doors closed.</li> <li>● Restroom areas are not for eating, playing, climbing or "hanging out "with friends.</li> </ul>
<b>Playground</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Voice level up to 5.</li> <li>● Take turns when using equipment.</li> <li>● Play safely and fairly.</li> <li>● Use kind words and actions.</li> <li>● No profanity.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Do not bring play equipment from home.</li> <li>● Keep playground clean and free of litter.</li> <li>● Be aware of activities, PE classes or other games around you.</li> <li>● Return to play area after using restrooms.</li> <li>● The bark area is not for running or playing tag.</li> </ul> <p style="text-align: center;">STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO SELL ANYTHING ON CAMPUS UNLESS APPROVED BY THE PRINCIPAL.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Bark area is not for running or playing tag.</li> <li>● Keep your hands and feet to yourself.</li> <li>● Do not throw things at one another.</li> <li>● Rough-housing/play fighting is not allowed.</li> <li>● Do not speak to others who are outside the fence INCLUDING OUTSIDE VENDORS.</li> <li>● Follow all playground equipment rules.</li> <li>● Let a supervisor know if any equipment goes outside the fence.</li> </ul>

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	<b>Be Responsible &amp; Safe</b>	<b>Consequences</b>
<b>Cell phones</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Students must have a signed permission slip on file in office before bringing a cell phone to school.</li> <li>● Cell phones are turned in to the office or teacher daily.</li> <li>● If turning the cell phone in to the teacher, the phone must be stored securely.</li> <li>● If the cell phone is not turned in to the teacher or office and it is confiscated by an adult during the school day, a parent must pick it from the office. This is counted as a strike.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Three-Strike Policy...if there are 3 incidents of mis-use, the student will not be allowed to bring a cell phone to school.</li> </ul> <p>Incidents include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Having a cell phone at school without a permission slip.</li> <li>✓ Having a cell phone at school without turning it in to the teacher or the office.</li> </ul>
<b>Dress Code</b>	<p><b>NOT TO BE WORN AT SCHOOL...</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Baggy or saggy pants that expose underwear and must constantly be pulled up.</li> <li>● Pants with holes and rips above your mid-thigh or with holes and rips exposing underwear.</li> <li>● Slippers, pajamas, blankets.</li> <li>● Tank tops or underwear shirts.</li> <li>● Short shorts/short skirts, shorter than mid-thigh (see illustration).</li> <li>● Backless blouses, see-through tops.</li> <li>● Clothing that exposes your stomach.</li> <li>● Strapless or tube tops. Off shoulder tops without shoulder straps. Excessively low cut tops. Halter tops. Spaghetti strap tops. Tops with bra straps showing.</li> <li>● Spiked jewelry.</li> <li>● Flip flops.</li> <li>● Hats, caps, earmuffs are fine for outdoor weather protection only. Remove your head covering when in the classroom...pull down your hoodies.</li> <li>● Red apparel is prohibited. (NO ALL RED shoelaces, shoes, belts, shirts, shorts, pants, jackets, sweaters, sweatshirts, handkerchiefs, dresses, skirts, etc).</li> <li>● Clothing with symbols affiliated with illegal activities including drugs, alcohol, tobacco, violence or with Old English lettering.</li> <li>● Clothing or jewelry with symbols of hate, sex, racist groups, prejudice, gangs, obscene language or gestures.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Call home for a change of clothes.</li> <li>● If parent unable to be contacted, student will have a one day pass unless clothing is unsafe or offensive.</li> <li>● Student sent home to change clothes.</li> <li>● If student is warned 3 times about inappropriate clothing there will be another level consequence.</li> </ul>

<b>NOT ALLOWED AT SCHOOL</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Firearms.</li> <li>✓ Knives of any kind.</li> <li>✓ Explosives.</li> <li>✓ Poppers.</li> <li>✓ Any instrument that expels a projectile of any kind through the force of air pressure, CO2 pressure or spring action.</li> <li>✓ Anything with sharp edges or points or could be designed to use as a weapon.</li> <li>✓ Fidget spinners.</li> <li>✓ Chewing gum.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Tobacco/Cigarettes/Cigars/Matches/Lighters.</li> <li>✓ Over-the-Counter Medications.</li> <li>✓ Prescribed Medication.</li> <li>✓ Alcohol or Other Drugs.</li> <li>✓ Spray Paint/Paint Pens.</li> <li>✓ Dice. Playing Cards. Trading Cards, Pokemon.</li> <li>✓ Illegal drugs. Drug Paraphernalia.</li> <li>✓ Toys/Slime/Sports Equipment.</li> <li>✓ Items that distract others, interferes with learning or interrupts the general process of school programs.</li> <li>✓ Laser pointers.</li> <li>✓ Permanent markers.</li> <li>✓ Liquid Paper.</li> </ul>	<p>Depending on the item and the action of the student...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Confiscation &amp; Parent must pick up.</li> <li>✓ Repeat offenders will get additional consequences.</li> <li>✓ Suspension.</li> <li>✓ Expulsion.</li> </ul>
