DRESS CODE

Weber students are expected to adhere to the following uniform guidelines:

ONLY COLLARED SHIRTS

- Button-down or polo.
- Small brands logos are OK on polo shirts.
- NO RED OR BLUE.
- Appropriately buttoned.
- No bare midriffs.

PANTS/SKIRTS

- NO denim-jean material pants.
- Slack material ONLY.
- No sagging: pants must be worn at the waist.
- Skirts: at least knee length; capris must be calf length.
- No jeans, shorts, jeggings, or yoga pants, elastic ankles, or drawstrings on uniform pants.

SWEATSHIRTS/SWEATERS AND JACKETS

- No red or blue allowed.
- ONLY school, college, or military-affiliated logos are permitted.
- NO brand-name logos.
- High school team jerseys/sweatshirts OK on game day only.
- MUST wear collared shirt underneath.
- No denim jean type material.

ACCESSORIES

- Lanyards must follow the same standards as sweatshirts/sweaters and jackets.
- Headphones/ ear buds/ Air Pods are not to be worn while class is in session.
- No hats indoors at any time.
- Scarves must follow the same allowed colors.
- No rubber bands around the pant leg.
- Belts and buckles follow the same allowed colors, and appropriate emblems.
- No drug, gang, sexual or other inappropriate references for ALL clothing items.

INDUSTRY UNIFORMS

- Scrubs are permissible.
- Auto shop shirts are permissible, but may not be red or blue.

SHOES

- No stiletto/high heels, open toe or backless shoes.
- No sandals or Crocs.
- No red or blue insignia or trim, no solid neon colors.
