We are very excited for the 2021-2022 school year here at Cesar Chavez High School. We cannot wait to welcome all of our students back on campus!

This year, we will continue to focus on refining our instructional practices with an emphasis on equity, mastery of standards, trauma-informed instruction, and social-emotional learning. We will also continue to offer Delta College courses during and after the regular school day; students will have the opportunity to take college classes here at Chavez for free while they are still earning their high school diploma.

We will have a minimum day on the first day of school, August 2<sup>nd</sup>, and then continue our traditional weekly minimum days every Thursday, starting the first week of school. The bell schedule will remain the same as previous years, with regular days starting at 7:16am and ending at 2:13pm. Minimum days will start at 7:16am and end at 11:55am. There will be some three day weekends for students again this year, as teachers will have three professional development days throughout the year.
