### **COURSE DESCRIPTIONS**

## A J 21 Criminal Justice in Society - 3 Units

Advisories: Ability to read at 12th grade level | This course introduces the characteristics of the US criminal justice system, particularly the structure and function of US police, courts, and corrections. Focus is on crime measurement, explanations of/responses to crime, components of the system, and current challenges. Students are introduced to the origins and development of criminal law, legal process, and sentencing and incarceration policies. (HBCU, UC, CSU, C-ID AJ 110)

# **HIST 37 California History - 3 Units**

Advisories: Ability to read at 12th grade level | This course surveys California history from the period of European exploration to the present within an international and national comparative context. Emphasis is on native cultures, Spanish and Mexican periods, American infiltration and conquest, the Gold Rush, statehood and the formation of government, economic growth, and cultural and social development. (HBCU, UC, CSU)
