Attention all students and staff who have not had their picture taken for IDs. The make-up date will be Monday August 28<sup>th</sup>. You will notice that the IDs are color coded this year to your class color. Seniors are black, Juniors are maroon, Sophomores are orange and Freshmen are green. These are the colors you are to wear any time we do a class color spirit day. You are expected to dress appropriately for school every day, and to wear your IDs every day. Also a reminder, cell phones and ear buds are only allowed before school, at lunch, and after school.

Attention all club advisors, there is a mandatory advisor's meeting for ALL club advisors Friday August 25<sup>th</sup>. The meeting will be in the library at lunch. We will discuss everything you need to know this year and everything about Club Rush which is September 22<sup>nd</sup>. Club Charter packets are also ready. You must be chartered in order to be a club on campus. They are available outside of Ms. Lugo's office in the library.

If you have a job, you must have a Work Permit. It's against the law for a minor to work without a Work Permit in California. Work permits must be obtained at the start of a new job and renewed at the start of each new school year. All current work permits, including those issued by Child Welfare and Attendance over the summer, expire on Tuesday, August 15<sup>th</sup>, and must be renewed if you are still employed. If you are 16 or 17 years old and have a job, you may be eligible to enroll in Work Experience Education, an elective course which combines paid employment with classroom instruction. Work Experience students meet with Ms. Yescas, our Work Experience Teacher/Coordinator, once a week at school and can earn up to 10 elective credits per semester and a total of 20 elective credits per year. If you are interested in finding a job, Ms. Yescas can assist you with job leads, creating a resume, and developing the skills you need to get and keep a job.

If you need to renew your work permit or would like more information about Work Experience Education, stop by main office to see Ms. Yescas before school, during lunch or after school. The Work Experience office is located in the counseling area in the main office.

Attention Freshmen, we will be gathering applications for freshmen ASB and Leadership this week. Applications are due Friday. Freshmen elections will be held in your PE class Friday August 25<sup>th</sup>.
