

Want Access the Internet and a Computer at Home?





- Stockton Unified School District and the 1 Million Project Foundation are teaming up to provide up to 3,500 free hotspots and free laptops to students in grades 9-12
- Eligible Students will Receive (as long as devices remain available):
 - A free hotspot device with 10GB/month of free high-speed wireless data
 - Internet service for up to four years (until graduation) while still in a Stockton Unified District high school
 - A free laptop device that belongs to the student and doesn't get returned
 - Eligible students are those without reliable access to internet at home, or those without their own access to a computer outside of school.
- Students will complete a survey in the first few weeks to determine eligibility devices will be given to students at school starting in late September/early October
- NOTE: Because of a limited supply, not all eligible students may get devices

IDs and Lanyards

- > IDs and lanyards are to be worn at all times while on the Stagg campus
- > IDs are encouraged to obtain a school breakfast or lunch
- IDs are required to check out textbooks
- ➤ A visible student ID will be required to gain access to "The Spot" and the ASB Student Store
- Student IDs are required to enter all sporting events and student activities
- > Students' IDs will be scanned and will receive Hero points, which can be used in the student store.

Cell Phone Usage




Cell Phone Usage

Consequences for Violation of the Cell Phone Policy

- ➤ **1st violation** Cell phone will be confiscated and brought to the Student Support Office (M-1).

- \triangleright **2nd violation** Cell phone will be confiscated and brought to the Student Support Office (M-1).
 - Cell phone will only be released to a parent or guardian.
- > **3rd violation** Cell phone is confiscated and parent must contact Mr. G. Phillips.

Dress Code Violations

**Student attire that is deemed inappropriate is at the discretion of the administration.

- ➤ EXCESSIVE Red or Royal Blue
- > Sagging pants
- Excessive holes in jeans or pants or shorts
- Spiked or studded items (altered or not)
- > Wallet style or other chains
- Spaghetti straps, halter tops, tank shirts, shirts with bra straps showing or bare midriff exposed



- Athletic/Sports Jerseys of any kind or team (except for Stagg High School Team Jerseys)
- > Any gang related clothing or items
- Any items with inappropriate slogans or pictures
- > Any clothing that covers the face
- Pajamas or slippers (house shoes)
- > Blankets
- Do-Rags



Attendance and Tardies

- > School starts at 7:25 a.m. You should be seated in your classroom at this time.
- > Students with 10% or > absences are considered habitually truant.
- Habitually truant students may be SARBed to an alternative school placement.
- > Excessive tardies will result in students being given detention. Failure to serve detentions will result in students being placed on the "no-go" list.
