



Access Internet and Laptops at Home

Receive a **Free Hotspot Device** with **24/7 Internet Access**, and/or a **Free Laptop** from Stockton Unified School District & the 1Million Project!

Internet Access + Hard Work = Great Grades & Brighter Futures

With your device and high-speed wireless Internet connectivity, you can:

- Access the new curriculum
- Do research for your school papers and projects
- Watch teacher-assigned videos
- Learn how to complete a complicated math problem online
- Submit homework online
- Communicate with your teachers
- Practice for the SAT on Kahn Academy's website
- Gain the digital skills needed for today's jobs

Eligible Students will Receive (based on device availability)

- A **free hotspot** device with **10GB** per month of **free high-speed wireless data**
- Internet service for **up to four years** (until graduation) while still in a Stockton Unified District high school
- A **free laptop** device that will belong to your student

How Students Get Devices

- Students at all **SUSD High Schools** will complete a survey in the **first weeks of school** to determine their eligibility.
- Eligible students will be those without reliable internet access at home and those without access to their own computer outside of school.
- **Hotspots** and **Laptops** will be made available **as long as devices remain available**; however not all eligible students may receive devices due to demand.



Dear Parent/Guardian,

Great news! Our school district is partnering with the 1Million Project Foundation to provide free mobile devices and high-speed internet access to high school students who don't have reliable Internet access at home.

This means that **students can receive a free hotspot (hotspots provide free Wi-Fi connection with 10GB of free high-speed wireless data each month for up to four years while in high school.**

We know that many of our students' families can't provide internet access for everyone in their household. By participating in the 1Million Project, we can now eliminate connectivity challenges for some of our students so that they can keep up with their homework assignments and be better positioned to succeed in school.

Additionally, the district is updating devices at schools throughout the district. Through this effort a significant number of laptops will be made available. As part of this initiative, Stockton Unified School District will be **distributing functional laptops to eligible high school students to take home, keep, and use for free.**

With their free connected devices, students will be able to complete homework assignments from home, communicate with teachers, study online for college prep exams, download educational apps, and more.

This a completely free program for both our school district and your child to participate in. The 1Million Project Foundation never collects your address or any other information about you or your family.

We hope you are supportive of your child participating in this program. Student eligibility will be determined using a survey in the first few weeks of school. Devices will then be distributed to eligible students at school sometime in late September or October.
