5. World Language/Visual & Performing Arts - 1 year
6. Physical Ed - 2 years
7. 90 elective credits (9 classes)

Total: 230 credits

- B. English – 4 years required (ELD 4 and ENG1A can be used)
- C. Math - 3 years required/4 recommended

- G. College-preparatory elective - 1 year
