1. History – 2 years (World History, US History) plus Gov/Econ
2. English - 4 years (ELD 4 counts as one year of English)
3. Math - 3 years (must pass Algebra)
4. Science - 3 years (1 Biological, 1 Physical, 1 General)
5. World Language - 2 years
6. Visual and Performing Art – 1 year
7. Physical Ed - 2 years
8. College-prep elective – 1 year
9. 40 elective credits (4 classes)

Total: 230 credits

A-G Requirements (4 yr. colleges) (earn C- or better)

- A. History – 2 years (World History and US History)
- B. English – 4 years required (ELD 4 and ENG1A can be used)
- C. Math - 3 years required/4 recommended
- D. Science - 2 years required/3 recommended (1 Bio, 1 Physical)
- E. Language other than English - 2 years
- F. Visual and Performing Art - 1 year
- G. College-preparatory elective - 1 year
