California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has mandated the following rules for all California K-12 schools. The CDPH requires all students and adults to wear masks while inside school buildings when students are present. At minimum, the following rules must be followed at this time:

- 1. TK-12 grade students are required to mask indoors only.
- 2. Masks are not required outdoors.
- 3. All TK-12 grade students are required to wear masks while traveling on school buses.
- 4. Physical distancing is encouraged but not required.
- 5. Current symptom checker (Qualtrics) will remain in place for staff.

SUSD will abide by the above mandated (Public Health Directive) protocols until lifted or modified by the State.

Layer Prevention Strategies

Each classroom is equipped with:

- 1. Hospital grade HVAC system filters have been upgraded and are replaced frequently
- 2. Hand sanitizing stations
