Subject: **Regarding Update from California Department of Public Health**

Updates Federal & State:

- San Joaquin County Public Health (SJCPH) update on July 28, 2021
- Continue to follow the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) guidelines as set forth on July 12, 2021.
- New guidelines expected November 1, 2021 from CDPH regarding masks.

Updates from San Joaquin County Public Health:

- SJCPH will continue to follow the guidelines from CDPH
- Full in-person instruction.
- Mandated masks indoors; optional outdoors for recess and P.E.
- No minimum physical distancing requirement.
- Modified quarantine for students only: masked students who are exposed to a COVID19 positive masked student can stay in school *if* they have no symptoms and get tested twice a week
 - Vaccinated and unvaccinated masked students who come into close contact with someone with COVID19 can continue attending school in-person but must get tested at least twice weekly over 10 days, at minimum.
- If unvaccinated student came into close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID19 and the unvaccinated student was not wearing a mask, they must quarantine for at least 10 days since the day of last exposure
 - Or Quarantine can end after Day 7 if specimen collected on day 6 from last day of exposure tests negative.
