Free COVID-19 Vaccine Event!

All children ages 5 and up are now eligible for the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine! These safe, effective, and free vaccines help ensure your child and family stay safe and healthy. Vaccinating your children limits disruptions to their learning. Fully vaccinated students may remain in school and avoid interruptions to in-person education, even if they are exposed to someone with COVID-19, so long as they remain without symptoms.

To keep our school community as healthy as possible, Delores Huerta Elementary will be hosting a free COVID-19 vaccination event for our students and their families. This is a perfect opportunity to get everyone in your family vaccinated. This will be the first event, and we'll be hosting a follow-up event on a 2nd dose event date to be determined in DECEMBER to administer second doses.

- ▶ **WHERE: [Delores Huerta Elementary School]**

HOW TO REGISTER

WHO: This event is open to all students ages 5 and older and their families and staff.

- ▶ **STEP 1:** Visit [MyTurn.ca.gov](https://myturn.ca.gov)
- ▶ **STEP 2:** Select "COVID-19" for appointment type
- ▶ **STEP 3:** Click "Make an Appointment"
Tip! Select "individual appointment", even if you have multiple family members signing up for vaccines. These steps will have to be repeated for each family member.
- ▶ **STEP 4:** Answer the questions, and where the form asks for "Access Code" enter: **TKRTRNAYD9**
- ▶ **STEP 5:** Continue to answer all screening questions for each student or patient.

Registration can also be done in multiple languages by calling the COVID-19 hotline at 833-422-4255.

CONSENT – If parents/guardians are **not** able to be at the vaccine event with their student(s), a [consent form](#) (here's the form in [Spanish](#)) must be completed for each student being vaccinated. Please complete this form and be sure that your student has it the day of the event. These consent forms are also available at the school front desk. This form is not necessary if a parent or guardian will be accompanying their student.
