GROUP	Quarantine Requirements Due to Symptoms with No Known COVID Exposure
ALL PERSONS (Symptomatic with no known exposure)	• May return to school or work site after ten (10) day quarantine or with a negative COVID test, as long as person is symptom-free or a healthcare provider has confirmed non-COVID reasons for symptoms.

*Staff and Students must wear masks indoors and those who are not fully vaccinated are encouraged to wear a face covering in crowded outdoor settings or during activities that involve sustained close contact (including high-risk contact sports) with other unvaccinated individuals. Exposure is defined as being within 0-6 feet of a laboratory-confirmed COVID19 case for greater than 15 minutes in the aggregate over a 24-hr period.
