The Board prohibits, in any school or district school activity, unlawful discrimination, including discriminatory harassment, intimidation of any student based on the student's actual race, color, ancestry, national origin, ethnic group identification, age, religion, marital or parental status, physical or mental disability, sex. Complaints shall be filed no later than six months after the date on which the alleged discrimination, harassment or intimidation occurred.
